Bauzá credits her years at the esteemed Jesuit college as inspiring, “Every day is a chance to make a difference,” with Mullen feeling “blessed to have had the chance to go there, from friends, to my wife and more.” This is a chance to positively influence young students from Puerto Rico and we are happy
